The Critical Area Planting practice is available for several scenarios. It may be used for establishment of permanent vegetative cover on a site that is void/nearly void of vegetation due to natural or human disturbance, gully erosion repair in pasture or hay land, and temporary cover in row crop land that will be disturbed during construction of a structural practice. Cost-share rates are based on the scenario and if it is a temporary or permanent application. Temporary cover applications have additional restrictions of a maximum of \$176 per acre, cost-share may not exceed 10% of the total structural practice and the area is limited to the minimum acreage required for accessibility and construction activities. Agreements for permanent plantings are 10 years and 1 year for temporary plantings. Applications will be accepted from February 1st through March 1st.
